


a little about

I became pregnant at the age of 16 and was a single mom until David and I married in 2008. I've been a stay at home mom for 12 years caring for our special needs daughter Jacie.



We promise to give your child a great education.


We promise teach respect and acceptance for others, no matter their race, sexual preference, or religion.
